

## **SWIMMING POOL HANDOUT**

## PLACEMENT ON LOT

Minimum setback requirements for swimming pools are as follows:

- Must be located in either the rear yard or side yard of the dwelling.
- Must be located a minimum five (5) feet from any property line.
- Must be located a minimum twenty (20) feet from the livable portion or 15 feet from a non livable portion of a neighbor's residence.
- Must be located a minimum twelve (12) feet from the side property line of an adjacent vacant lot.
- Swimming pool must be enclosed with a minimum six (6) foot fence with self closing and self latching gates.
- Lighting must be directed so as to not cause a disturbance to neighboring properties.
- Pool equipment, pool sheds or equipment buildings must meet the requirements of the adopted building code and Hooper City zoning for placement and permits.

## PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The following documentation is required for a swimming pool permit:

- \_\_\_\_\_1 Completed Hooper City permit application.
- 2-2 sets of engineered building plans.
- <u>3 2 copies of the site plan. Site plan must be drawn to scale (minimum scale 1"=20') and include actual</u> setbacks from property lines and existing structures for the pool and associated equipment and the location of any windows or other openings in the dwelling. (See example on reverse side)
- 4 Building permits are required for equipment buildings over 200 sq. ft.; compliance permits are required if under 200 sq. ft.

## DISCLAIMER

The information on this handout is not intended to be a complete list of requirements for swimming pools. This information is however a general list of those items which are typically overlooked or missed by the owner or builder. Whether the work is done by a licensed General Contractor, or by the homeowner, both are required to comply with all model codes adopted by the State of Utah, as well as Hooper City ordinances.
